

## MediEase 3.3+ Adjusting Rubella/MMR Compliance Rule for Patients Born Prior to 1957

The default MediEase immunization rules for Rubella and MMR calculate the patient as compliant if they were born before January 1, 1957. The following procedure changes the Rubella requirement so that all patients, no matter when they were born, are required to be immunized for Rubella. If you want to make the same change for Measles and Mumps, repeat the following steps for Measles and Mumps.

1. If MediEase is open, exit the program.
2. Open the Immunization Maintenance Module (IMM). Under the **Immunization** tab choose Rubella and click the **Edit** button.
3. This will open the Immunization window for Rubella. Highlight **General** under the Compliance Rule list box. Click the **Edit** button.
4. In the box titled: To be compliant, patient must: highlight **be born before 01/01/1957** and click the **Delete** button. At this point you should have two Or statements together, highlight either one and click the **Delete** button.
5. Click the **OK** buttons until you are back at the main window for the IMM. **Close the IMM.**
6. Start MediEase and choose a patient born before 1957, notice that they are now non-compliant for Rubella.
